## Celebrating November Milestones



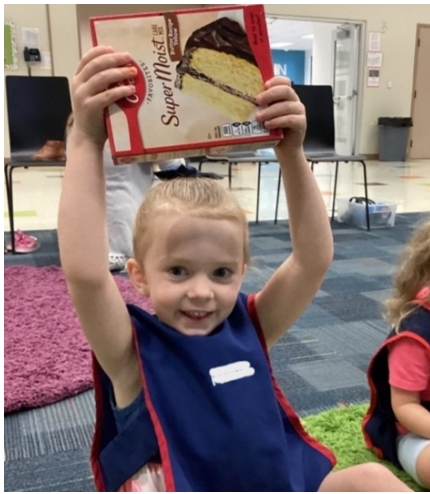
### Day of Thankfulness

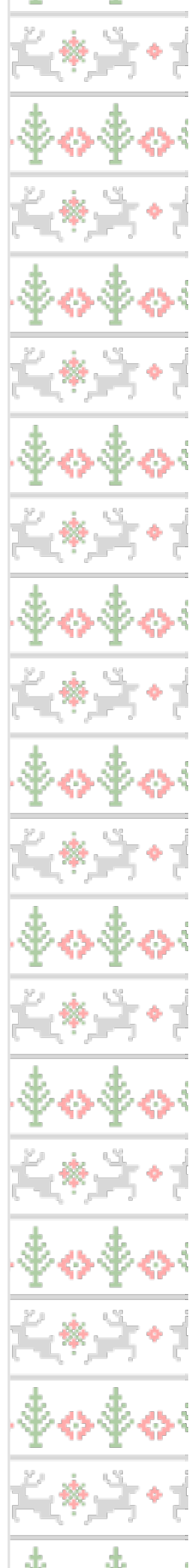
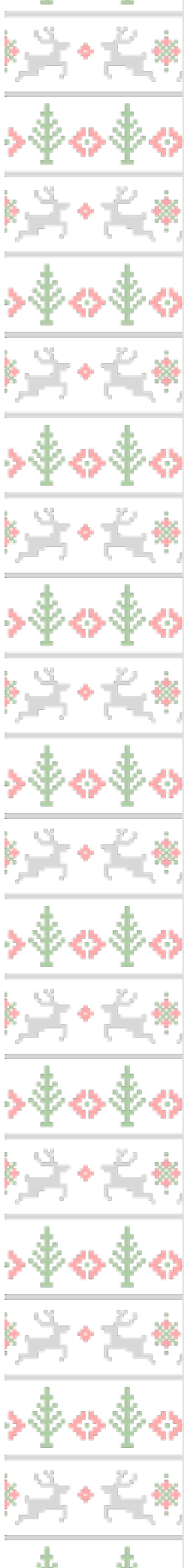

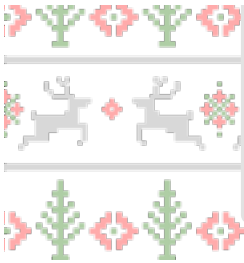
